Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program

The Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing (ABSN) program at Baldwin Wallace University invites applications from nurses with significant teaching experience at the collegiate level or in a hospital setting, for a full-time, twelve-month, renewable term, Assistant Professor position. The responsibilities of this position include teaching Medical Surgical Nursing and serving as the Nursing Lab Coordinator. Experience with laboratory simulation education is required. The search will remain open until the position is filled with a qualified individual.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate the management of the Nursing Laboratory— policies/procedures, facilities, supplies and equipment.
- Collaborate with faculty to develop and implement a curriculum that is reflective of course concepts, exemplars, objectives and outcomes.
- Teach medical surgical nursing concepts and exemplars in the didactic setting.
- Prepare students to think critically, communicate accurately, and perform indicated therapeutic nursing interventions in the laboratory setting.
- Implement teaching and learning strategies that support student application of theoretical learning to laboratory patient situations.
- Create an environment that fosters student learning in all settings.
- Evaluate student performance and provide feedback to enhance student learning.
- Participate in nursing faculty meetings and department/university events.

Required (Minimum) Qualifications:

- At least two years of experience as a registered nurse
- Evidence of clinical competency in medical-surgical nursing
- An unencumbered license as a registered nurse in the state of Ohio.
- Clean background check and drug screen (to be done after interview)
- Earned nursing degree:

- Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) -- required if the basic nursing degree is not a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN).
- Those with a BSN and a master's degree in a non-nursing field will be considered.
- Experience using laboratory simulation to teach nursing
- Must pass a background check and all required university compliance training

Preferred Qualifications:

- Earned MSN degree with a specialization in Nursing Education or coursework in instruction, curriculum development and/or student evaluation.
- Earned DNP or PhD degree
- Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator (CHSE) certification
- Experience with nursing research and/or evaluation
